# **GOVERNMENT DECREE**

of 11 May 2016

on determination of thresholds and amounts for the purposes of the Act on Public Procurement

Pursuant to Section 18 (3) a) and Section 25 of Act No. 134/2016 Coll., on Public Procurement, the government hereby decrees the following:

#### Section 1

### Introductory provisions

This government decree implements the relevant legislation of the European Union<sup>1</sup>, and, simultaneously, it follows to the directly applicable legislation of the European Union<sup>2</sup> and regulates a) thresholds for determination of above-threshold public contracts,

b) amounts for the purposes of the possibility to set aside an individual part of the public contract which does not have to be awarded by procedures corresponding to the total estimated value of the public contract.

## §Section 2

# Threshold for determination of above-threshold public supply contract

- (1) Unless stipulated in subsection (2) otherwise, the threshold for determination of an above-threshold public supply contract shall amount to
- a) CZK 3,686,000 in respect of the contracting authorities specified in Section 4 (1) a) to c) of the Act on Public Procurement (hereinafter referred to as 'the Act'); this shall not apply to a contracting authority operating in the field of defence in cases listed in subparagraph 1 of paragraph b),
- b) CZK 5,706,000 in respect of contracting authorities specified in
  - 1. Section 4 (1) a) to c) of the Act operating in the field of defence, where the subject-matter of the public contract does not cover products listed in the Annex to this Decree,
  - 2. Section 4 (1) d) and e) of the Act,
  - 3. Section 4 (2) of the Act, or
  - 4. Section 4 (5) of the Act.
- (2) The threshold for determination of an above-threshold utilities public supply contract or for determination of an above-threshold public supply contract in the fields of defence and security shall amount to CZK 11,413,000.

### Section 3

### Threshold for determination of above-threshold public service contract

- (1) Unless stipulated in subsections (2) to (4) otherwise, the threshold for determination of an above-threshold public service contract shall amount to
- a) CZK 3,686,000 in respect of contracting authorities specified in Section 4 (1) a) to c) of the Act,
- b) CZK 5,706,000 in respect of contracting authorities specified in
  - 1. Section 4 (1) d) and e) of the Act,
  - 2. Section 4 (2) of the Act, or
  - 3. Section 4 (5) of the Act.
- (2) The threshold for determination of an above-threshold public service contract in cases of a utilities public contract or a public contract in the fields of defence and security shall amount to CZK 11,413,000.

- (3) The threshold for determination of an above-threshold public contract which is a services concession shall amount to CZK 142,668,000.
- (4) The threshold for determination of an above-threshold public service contract being awarded in light regime shall amount to CZK 20,478,000, with the exception of
- a) a utilities public service contract, in which case the threshold shall amount to CZK 27,305,000,
- b) services concession, in which case the threshold shall amount to CZK 142,668,000.

#### Section 4

# Threshold for determination of above-threshold public works contract

Threshold for determination of an above-threshold public works contract shall amount to CZK 142,668,000.

# Section 5

The amount for the purposes of the possibility to set aside an individual part of the public contract

The amount for an individual part of the public contract which does not have to be awarded by procedures corresponding to the total estimated value of the public contract pursuant to Section 18 (3) of the Act, shall amount to

- a) CZK 2,184,000 in respect of supplies and services,
- b) CZK 27,305,000 in respect of works.

Section 6

**Effect** 

This decree comes into effect on 1 October 2016.
